Steering Wheel Installation

Congrats on receiving your new Woody's steering wheel! Below are the simple steps to removing your old steering wheel and installing your new one correctly.

1. Removing the old one:

- Center the old steering wheel so your truck wheels are facing forward.
- Take the horn button off.
- Loosen and remove the wheel nut.
- By using a steering wheel puller which can be purchased at most truck/parts centers, pull off the old steering wheel.

2. Installing the new one:

- Center the steering wheel over the column.
- Carefully set the steering wheel down on the column, lining up with the splines and settling it in as much as possible.
- Replace the wheel nut, and tighten down.
- Put the horn button on and enjoy!

3. Adjustments & removal of wood steering wheel:

• ALWAYS use a steering wheel puller to remove the Woody's Okoume wood steering wheel for any reason, to prevent breakage.
